

9th Grade and New High School Student Supply List

Please bring these supplies with you every day to school. Individual main lesson teachers will add additional supplies to this list as the year progresses.

3-ring binder notebook – the big study cloth covered ones that snap or zip shut and contain additional pockets or folders are excellent.
Lined loose-leaf paper for your notebook (regular ruled, not college ruled)
Several folders with pockets for handouts
A pocket calendar or daybook to write down your homework assignments
#2 pencils with erasers
Mechanical pencil
Pencil Sharpener
Good quality eraser
Fountain pen – blue and black ink (blue for ML book pages in high school)
Ink eraser pen (for fountain pen ink, available at Turose)
White-out pen
Fine point roller ball style or pilot pens (black)
Colored pencils – at least 24 colors. (Invest in a high quality set from an art supply store. You will use them for every main lesson.)
Case for pencils and pens
Calligraphy pen (available from Turose on first day of school)

9th Grade Geometry Block Supply List
